OXYGEN QUALIFICATIONS

The treating physician has determined that the patient has a severe lung disease or hypoxia-related symptoms that might be expected to improve with oxygen therapy.

- Shortness of breath or Pneumonia or dyspnea is not a qualifying diagnosis
- Hypoxemia will qualify but it must be charted that it is expected to improve with oxygen therapy.

The qualifying blood gas study was performed by a physician or by a qualified provider or supplier of laboratory services.

- If you spot check the patient, you must put that the patient was **at rest on room air.**
 - In a clinic, the patient must meet O2 sat of 88% or below. If this is done by walking the patient, you must have 3 sats - before walk on RA, during walk on RA, and after walk - with oxygen on them.

If the test is done overnight, you must have records that the patient was seen by physician within 30 days of delivered oxygen.
